As much as we can be proud of policing by consent, the time has passed where all Gardai need to be armed to at least be able to protect themselves. If they can't protect themselves they certainly can't protect us. As a military policeman for 12 years I never went on duty without my sidearm. In that time I never shot anyone or had to draw down on anyone but it was always good to know it was there!!
